December Greetings!



Keynote Speakers Announced

Our first evening speaker, Jeannine Schweihofer, Associate Director of the MSU Extension Agriculture and AgriBusiness Institute, will welcome us to Lansing.

Keynote Speaker Karen Eddington will share: "Strong Under Pressure" and "Stress Surfing: Get Skills to Ride the Waves."

Karen is a 20-year identity researcher and author of Understanding Self-Worth.

Originally from rural Utah, Karen shares in her

presentations stress management skills with a focus on how to be strong under pressure.
